

## **Elaine Seymour**

Elaine Seymour is the Director of Ethnography and Evaluation Research, Bureau of Sociological Research, University of Colorado, Boulder, a position she has held since 1989. She received a Ph.D. in Sociology from the University of Colorado, a M.A. in Education from the University of Glasgow, Scotland, and a B.A. with Honors in Economics and Political Science from Keele University, England. Her academic honors include Doctoral Fellowships from the National Institute of Mental Health and the University of Colorado, Teaching Excellence Awards, and a Fulbright Teaching Scholarship. Seymour's recent work in assessment includes the development of a prototype Field-Tested Learning Assessment Guide (FLAG) --a web-site of classroom assessment tools for science, mathematics and engineering faculty engaged in pedagogical innovation, and the development of the Student Assessment of their Learning Gains (SALG) classroom evaluation instrument.
