### WHAT IS THE GLOBAL CITIZENS CREDENTIAL?

The Global Citizens Credential (GCC) allows you to develop international expertise which can help you stand-out when applying to jobs and ensure your success in an increasingly competitive and interconnected world. The GCC can also help you become a more engaged and responsible 'global citizen'.

You are eligible to enroll if you are an undergraduate student in good academic standing (2.0 GPA or above). To earn the GCC, you must register online, complete a minimum of 10 points, and attend a Capstone Symposium.

### POINTS ARE AWARDED FOR:

#### Global Courses

Having an approved global major/minor or taking a course with a global-focus

#### Learning Abroad

Participating in a learning abroad experience

#### Language Proficiency

Having a foreign language major/minor, taking an upper-division foreign language course, or demonstrating proficiency in a language other than English

#### Global Scholarly Work

Participating in undergraduate research, conference, training, or workshop that focuses on a global topic

#### Intercultural Activities

Attending intercultural activities or serving as leader, intern, or volunteer with an internationally focused organization

If you successfully complete the GCC, you will receive a **transcript notation**, a **signed certificate**, and an **honor cord** to wear at graduation.
